Sir,

Kindly refer to your letter Reference no 98/VC/NBU/AMM-09 dated 16.06.2009, addressed to the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor regarding extension of affiliation in History Honours, Bengali Honours and Philosophy General for the academic session 2009 – 2010 in Alipurduar Mahila Mahavidyalaya. In this regard the undersigned is desired to inform you that in view of the exigency as expressed by the College the University has approved the introduction of History Honours and Bengali Honours with an intake of 20 students in Alipurduar Mahila Mahavidyalaya from the academic session 2009-2010 subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions

- i. The College shall appoint one full time teacher in each subject (Bengali and History) and two part time teachers in History Honours before commencement of classes. The College shall send a copy of their appointment letters of the teachers (based on University norms) along with the compliance report to the University positively within 31.07.2009.
- ii. The College shall procure at least two hundred text books in Bengali and History Honours including reference books in consonance with the syllabi of respective subjects within 30th July, 2009.
- iii. The maximum intake in Bengali and History Honours shall be 20.
- iv. The College shall submit a declaration to the University in the form that the reasonable additional expenditure required for the purposes of introduction of History (Honours) and Bengali (Honours) from the academic session 2009 – 2010 shall be borne by the College till creation of new posts (as recommended) and joining of the incumbent to the approved substantive posts / sanction of posts.
- v. The same inspection team of the University will visit the College during September, 2009 or earlier after the receipt of the statement of compliance (the last date of such compliance is 31st July, 2009) from the College authority to ascertain whether the College has fulfilled the conditions. The University shall reserve the right to disaffiliate the recommended course by withdrawing the letter of recommendation on the basis of the report of the inspection team if there is any non-compliance.
- vi. The College is also advised to be ready with required Faculty, sufficient Class rooms as well as sufficient number of books with the view that the College would be in a position to begin Philosophy (General) within one or two year subject to fresh inspection.
- vii. The report of compliance shall be submitted to the University positively by 31st July, 2009.
