Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. Title Page (Article title, abstract of around 500 words in Times New Roman (English) 12 font size, 1.15-line spacing)
2. Abstract Title: 14 font size
3. Author Details: In Time New Romans, 12 font size (bold), affiliation and Email ID must be submitted.
4. Keywords: Not exceeding (4-6), 10 font size.

Full Paper Submission Guidelines

1. Introduction
2. Literature Review
3. Database & methods
4. Discussion
5. Conclusions
6. Reference

Full paper must be 3000-4500 words. The paper must be written in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx and pdf) using Time New Romans (English) 12 font size, double line spacing following APA reference style (7th edition). The full paper must include the abstract (500 words), keywords (4-6), affiliating institution, Email-id and corresponding details.

- c. The selected papers will be presented by the authors at the Seminar. Full papers are to be submitted within 15 days of receiving the letters of selection of Abstracts.
